

BIBLICAL PRINCIPLES WHICH FORM THE BASIS FOR OUR MINISTRY

- A.** All people have a need for more wholeness in their lives. Salvation (soteria) means “wholeness” in every aspect of our lives and includes provision for our physical, emotional and spiritual needs.
- B.** God by His Spirit is able to meet our human needs. As Jesus said, “*For mortals it is impossible, but for God all things are possible.*” (Mat 19:26 NRSV)
- C.** God has made eternal promises to His people. Faith is the means by which we take hold of and act on the promises of God. He does not expect us to drum up enough faith in our own strength. God gives us sufficient faith. We just ask him for it.
- D.** Our Healing Ministry believes what God has promised in His Word and seeks to act on those promises.
- E.** Our ministry also seeks to encourage those to whom we minister to believe and act on His promises and to pray for the faith to do so.
- F.** We don’t have the power to heal people. That is what God alone can do. However, He may use us to bring blessing and healing in the lives of other people. To God is the glory in every situation for what He does. We don’t assign or accept the glory to ourselves.
