## *Healing Thoughts* - **The Hound of Heaven** – Kirsten Aufhammer

One of the best things about writing for a weekly newsletter is that I get a chance to watch God enter into the mundane areas of life to reveal Himself. I was recently the recipient of one of His visits into the mundane. He showed up when I was watching a movie!

While I was on vacation I got locked inside of my friend's house. Her middle son unknowingly closed the new screen door, which locked from the outside, trapping me inside the house. The only other exit was guarded by the meanest looking dog you've ever seen. Having been warned not to, under any circumstance, go near the dog...I was hesitant to introduce myself to him for the first time trying to escape from the house. My friend's youngest son told me that he would come to my rescue, but he was currently out on his boat fishing. As he headed into shore he told me to make myself at home, watch a movie, and relax.

I figured I was on vacation...why not stretch out on the couch, watch a movie, and relax. The only DVD I could find that looked half interesting was the movie **Taken** starring Liam Neeson. While the movie tended towards the violent side, the plot of the story fascinated me – especially viewed through Christian lenses. The movie is about a seventeen year old girl, Kim, who wants to travel to Paris (sans parents) with another one of her friends. When they reach Paris they share a cab with a good looking, charming young man because he points out that the fare is extremely expensive. The young man's intentions were less than noble and more than devious. He sets the girls up. Shortly after arriving where the young women will be staying, Kim is on the phone with her dad, Bryan (Liam). She sees her friend, through a window in the house, being kidnapped by some men. Bryan, as an ex-CIA operative, calmly begins to instruct Kim on what to do when the men find her and kidnap her as well! Bryan, soon realizes that the young women have been sold into the sex trade business. He stops at nothing -no matter how difficult the obstacle- to find, rescue, and bring his daughter back to her family.

As I watched the movie I was reminded that we have a Heavenly Father Who stopped at nothing – not even the life of His Son (John 3:16) – to bring us into (or back into) His family. In the movie, Bryan was beaten, tortured, and betrayed by friends as he risked his life to save his precious daughter. Jesus experienced the same treatment when He chose to come save each of us. If Bryan, as an earthly parent, stopped at nothing to save his daughter from evil don't you know that Jesus will do even more to save His children from whatever tries to harm them. He has proven that to all of us by being willing to die for us.

Whether you have been kidnapped by a disease, addiction, loneliness, depression, loss of a job, etc know that Jesus has done/is doing/will do whatever it takes to keep you close in His embrace. You are His family; His beloved children. Trust Him to come find you wherever the kidnappers have taken you. He won't ever give up! So be on the lookout for Him. No matter what has kidnapped you, stand firm in hope that your Savior will rescue you some how and some way! He will show up when you least expect, setting you free from whatever is trying to keep you prisoner!

Prayer requests are placed in a special basket at *The Glennon House* for one month. These requests are prayed for, individually, each day by prayer volunteers.
