Healing Thoughts - **Jesus is My Anchor** – Patrice Hays

Dear Healing Ministry at All Saints Church,

I just wanted to share with you how Jesus spoke to me through an Oprah show last week. Yes, Oprah! I was watching Oprah while getting ready for work last Thursday and heard her ask the guest "So, you are saying that when your father died, it was like losing an anchor in your life?". And the guest said "Yes". And then I knew that Jesus was speaking to me. That He is my anchor, my rock, a source of strength, and always connected to me. I realized then, that the worry and anxiety I had been experiencing the last few weeks regarding paying my taxes was something that my father would help me with (take care of) and that I had felt that I lost my anchor - my "back up plan". Not necessarily in terms of money, but guidance, advice, skill and calmness knowing that everything would be ok. Since my father's death six years ago, my mother and I have both embarked on a journey learning how to handle things Dad used to handle, without him. Mom was married to him for 36 years and that was something he handled for the both of them. I, too, relied on his expertise, and from time to time, some financial help.

Instead of saying to myself "I need to do this by myself", "How do I do this?" or "Who can help me?" I realized that Jesus desires me to come closer to him, and know him more. What became clear to me on Thursday was that Jesus wants me to realize that He is forever my Anchor! That any questions I would ask Dad if he were alive, I can ask Jesus, and He will guide me. Jesus has been at the center of my family since before I was born and I know in times when even Dad needed guidance, Jesus guided him!

My mother and I continue on our journey to learn how to worry less about finances, and seek reliable resources to guide us in areas that we need. I have found a reputable accountant that is guiding me to a place of more financial stability. For this I praise the Lord!

And as I study the lessons I have learned from the Glennon House, amidst the laying of worry at Jesus' feet, I make a list, and read aloud to Jesus, praise for the blessings He has so gracefully given me.

Even a year ago, I wouldn't have even thought that Jesus would reach out so strongly to me, drawing me closer. Or, if He had a year ago, I didn't see it as I see it now.

Jesus seeks us. His hand is always reaching. Today I make a new commitment to look up, reach out, and live in joy daily, knowing that He is my Anchor!
