GIFTS TO: THE HEALING MINISTRY at ALL SAINTS CHURCH, Winter Park

Funding of The Healing Ministry at All Saints Church, Winter Park, is independent from the parish budget of All Saints Church. The Healing Ministry relies primarily upon contributions made at the Tuesday evening Healing Services and by donations made during visits to *The Glennon House*. The operating costs of *The Glennon House*, its staff, prayer ministry, healing missions and some specially acquired guest teachers, are derived from those generous donations and contributions.

The Healing Ministry is an ecumenical expression of the healing gifts of Jesus Christ and welcomes the involvement of believers of every Christian denomination.

Healing Thoughts - A Relationship With Our Lord Means Work – Doris Matthews

"...For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
(Ephesians 2:10)

Is this a familiar theme for you? *"I try listening and being quiet but my mind will not be still."* *"Does he really hear me?"* *"He never answers my prayers."*

I have to ask, what is your line of work? Pilot? Surgeon? Plumber? How many hours of study did it take to get your certificate, license, diploma? Did you find a quiet place to prepare your lessons, a text book, pad and pencil? Did you listen to the professor and take notes and share with others? Did you make that time a priority?

If the desire of your heart is to hear the voice of the Lord in your life, how much effort are you willing to spend? Although Romans 8 tells us *"nothing can separate us from the love of God"*, sometimes our trials and troubles create a wall that separates us from God's presence. Instead of seeking the Lord's presence, we keep up a constant unrelenting parade of our troubles morning and night, making it impossible to hear the Lord and all He has for us.

For a relationship with the Lord, put on a cloak of determination and set out in body, mind and spirit. Take as your creed: ***"I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts. I will look to see what he will say to me and what answer I am to give....."*** (Habakkuk 2:1)

Here is one method. The time span might be weeks, months or the rest of your life. The main focus is to press on regardless, in spite of boredom, laziness, or lack of response. Refuse to give up your appointed time. Ask Him to show you the way. Make Him the rock you stand on in faith if not by sight. Keep in mind the Lord is there with you. He is determined to bring you into one with Him, healing anything which might be keeping you from Him.

1. Pick a time to worship the Lord, preferably the same time every day and stick to it (whether 5 minutes or an hour). Put that time first before all others.
2. Find a quiet comfortable place to pray with bible, pad and pencil in hand
3. Let silence emerge. Surrender all, body mind and spirit.
4. Read scriptures – note any that seem to speak to you in a special way, write down and memorize.
5. Read a Psalm aloud, i.e., Protection – Psalm 91; Me Alone - Psalm 139
6. Let silence emerge again. *"Search me O God, and know my heart"*. Note any thoughts that come to mind. Read yesterday's notes.

THE PRAYER REQUESTS YOU GIVE TO US:

Prayer requests are placed in a special basket at *The Glennon House* for one month. These requests are prayed for, individually, each day by prayer volunteers.
