GIFTS TO: THE HEALING MINISTRY at ALL SAINTS CHURCH, Winter Park

Funding of The Healing Ministry at All Saints Church, Winter Park, is independent from the parish budget of All Saints Church. The Healing Ministry relies primarily upon contributions made at the Tuesday evening Healing Services and by donations made during visits to *The Glennon House*. The operating costs of *The Glennon House*, its staff, prayer ministry, healing missions and some specially acquired guest teachers, are derived from those generous donations and contributions.

The Healing Ministry is an ecumenical expression of the healing gifts of Jesus Christ and welcomes the involvement of believers of every Christian denomination.

Dylan's 6th grade assignment was to write a speech about someone who has "touched lives and secured futures". As a young baby, Dylan was prayed for many times, by Healing Ministry volunteers and/or staff, for a variety of different surgeries. Those prayers not only helped to heal him physically, but as you will read he has been healed mentally and spiritually as well.

"Do not murder, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not give false testimony, honor your father and mother,' and **love** your neighbor as yourself." Do you know who said this? The person who said this has touched more lives in the world than anybody. He is known as Jesus.

Jesus performed miracles. In this way, He touched many lives. He healed a man who had been blind his entire life. He made a crippled man walk. He walked on water. He changed water into wine at a wedding. He was able to feed thousands of people with only two fish and a loaf of bread. He still heals people today physically, mentally, and spiritually.

Some of the people whose lives He touched were His followers. His twelve closest friends were His disciples. The disciples were so touched by Jesus' teachings that they taught the word of God to everyone they met. They watched Him perform miracles and some of them kept written records of what they saw.

Not only did He touch lives, Jesus also secured better futures for everyone. He taught values to people, so that they would do the right thing forever. He helped the poor and the needy. This showed the rest of the world how to act. He was very wise, so his knowledge secured a better future for those who followed his teachings. He also died on the cross so that all of our sins would be forgiven and so that we could have eternal life with Him in heaven.

Jesus still touches lives today, including mine. He touched my life because I have chosen to follow Him. I am fascinated with him. He has given me a good life. I try to follow the rule, "to whom much is given, much is expected". If everybody was as loving and compassionate as Jesus, the world would be a much better place.

We are all supposed to do Jesus' work in the world. If we live by God's word, then we will have eternal life. Jesus has earned my loyalty and respect, and I hope He earns yours, too.

Grief Ministry

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned: the flames will not set you ablaze.....Isaiah 43:2 (NIV)

Come to Me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.....Matthew 12:28-30 (NLT)

I find these words of the prophet Isaiah very comforting; yet, when I was in the middle of a life storm they sometimes fell on deaf ears. Sometimes when we are in the middle of coping with a painful loss, we can bounce between knowing the grace of God, wondering where He is, or even wondering if He is real at all. Yet in spite of the pain, confusion, and doubt, we can do more than just survive. With the help, guidance, wisdom, and love of the Lord Jesus we can journey through the valley of the shadow of grief and become new creations (2 Corinthians 5:17). Beloved I pray that God will renew you and give you rest. I know that He can do much more than help you survive your loss; He can teach you to live a new life complete with joy and contentment.
