Topics: Tuesday 31st – *Deliverance From Evil and Interecession*

This prayer laboratory is a place where we might gather to test our theories and abilities concerning prayer. It should be seen more as “trying out” various forms of prayer rather than learning how someone else does them.

There are some prerequisites to all prayer. We must decide whether we are trying to discern and walk in God’s will or trying to get God to do our will. Jesus taught us to pray, “Thy will be done...” (Excerpt from Prayer Laboratory by Fr. Al Durrance)

And many others types of fear: others, finances, encounters, and fear itself. He will stress that we need to take our fear, along with our illness, and present it to Christ – never taking it back. Jesus forgives our fear and heals us.

Don will also be encouraging others on how to sustain their healing and curing. He will be discussing some of the barriers that the enemy tries use to make us doubt our healing/curing. Another item Don will be discussing is our responsibility in sustaining our healing.

Prayer Basket

As many of you know we have a Prayer Basket at the Glennon House that is filled to overflowing with prayer requests from all over the world. Each day the Healing Ministry phones ring with faithful friends, family members, and even strangers calling in prayers for others. At any given time there are about 300 names in the prayer basket. When prayer requests are placed in the basket they are prayed over by Healing Ministry volunteers at least once a day for an entire month.

Healing Thoughts - He Was There – Martha Tiller

David says in Psalm 139, "If I make my bed in Sheol, Thou are there."

My personal journey took me to Sheol and although I didn't know it at the time, I didn't travel alone, He was there. He was there through the dark days of my mental illness. He was there through the captivity of drug addiction. And when the Psychiatrists would patch me up so that I could have an on again off again career in music and entertainment, He was there. After 25 years of a losing battle He was there in that Christian Psychiatrist who said "There's nothing more doctors can do for you, only Jesus can heal and deliver you."

Those were the words that would save my life. On July 12th 1974 this spirit filled doctor sent me back to my own church, The Cathedral Church of St Luke where two godly prayer warriors prayed deliverance for me for the better part of a day. I walked into that prayer room a mess of a human being and walked out a miracle of God. Our Lord's ways are full of wonder.

This Master Potter can mold a mess into a message. Thanks be to God. The Word says "the seed of the righteous will be delivered." Because I was blessed with two righteous parents, God was there that day keeping His promise to them. This was just the beginning of a long healing walk. The road ahead was wonderful and yet at times painful beyond words. But He was there.

My mother became victim to Alzheimer's. I would not have made it had He not been there during that long good bye. And always He has given me a song to sing even in the darkest nights of the soul. I look forward to sharing the glory of His presence with you.

Perhaps some of you know me from the Cathedral. Others may have heard me sing at The old Langford Hotel or other places during my former career. We may have met as I ministered at WAJL Christian radio. My name is Martha Tiller and I grew up in Orlando, loved unconditionally by a Christian mother who was also there storming the gates of heaven for her child. As I share the message of His faithfulness with you, I know that He will be there and we will experience His awesome healing presence once more. May the peace of the Lord be with you.

Prayer requests are placed in a special basket at *The Glennon House* for one month. These requests are prayed for, individually, each day by prayer volunteers. Grief Ministry

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned: the flames will not set you ablaze.....Isaiah 43:2 (NIV)

Come to Me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light.....Matthew 12:28-30 (NLT)

I find these words of the prophet Isaiah very comforting; yet, when I was in the middle of a life storm they sometimes fell on deaf ears. Sometimes when we are in the middle of coping with a painful loss, we can bounce between knowing the grace of God, wondering where He is, or even wondering if He is real at all. Yet in spite of the pain, confusion, and doubt, we can do more than just survive. With the help, guidance, wisdom, and love of the Lord Jesus we can journey through the valley of the shadow of grief and become new creations (2 Corinthians 5:17). Beloved I pray that God will renew you and give you rest. I know that He can do much more than help you survive your loss; He can teach you to live a new life complete with joy and contentment.
