Healing Thoughts - **Big Bang** – Nickie Sarner

It was Saturday, February 28th, and I had just finished a weekend workshop given by Fr. Nigel Mumford. For some reason, this workshop really spoke to me very deeply. Perhaps because Fr. Nigel was a member of the elite Her Majesty's Royal Marine Commandos, and my son and his father are former U.S. Marines. Our Marine Corps has a deep and abiding respect for the British Marines, and we can understand the tremendous change necessary to go from hand-to-hand combat to hand-to-hand healing!

This whole workshop was a real learning experience for me in many ways. As you know, I am no stranger to our Lord's healing, and have participated in our prayer team for some time. He has touched me and my children many times with His healing love and has cared for us through many difficult times. So, during this weekend, I picked up the booklet *Hand-to-Hand* and looked it over before heading home on Saturday afternoon. I was particularly touched with the prayers towards the end of the booklet. It tells us to "Expect a Miracle!" I tucked the booklet into my purse and headed home.

On my way home, I was turning left with the light when I suddenly heard a thunderous sound, I was completely enclosed in a blinding white light! The next thing I knew, my car had been hit, twisted over two lanes of traffic heading in the opposite direction and unable to move. I heard people yelling "get out of the car...gasoline is all over..get out of the car."...I could not move because the seatbelt had pinned me to the seat and the driver's air bag pushed me back into the seat. As the Lord would have it, this accident took place at the intersection of two main streets, one of which had an ice cream shop on the corner. It just happened to be the shop my granddaughter works in part time..and she was working and witnessed the entire accident! She rushed out, opened my seat belt and helped me to the curb where some kind person had brought a chair for me.

I sat and looked at my car...which seemed to be the victim of some giant blade that cut off the entire front end, shattering the windshield! However, I felt no pain..none. The medics came and my granddaughter called her mom (my daughter) who is a nurse. By this time, the paramedics had started working on me, and the hurting started. Karen my daughter, appeared and had them sign over my case to them, and she rushed me to her hospital's emergency room. For 12 hours the doctors worked on me. They were shocked to find that my injuries consisted of three fractured ribs, a badly twisted left foot and a huge amount of bruises and muscular wrenching! No loss of limb, no facial damage from shattered glass, and no internal damage! I refused to enter the hospital, since the treatment was pain pills, rest and somebody to be with me throughout the following five days and nights. My daughter and her three children took turns staying with me as I steadily got better. All during that process, I read and re-read my little Hand-to-Hand book which inspired me so much...and which convinced me that the Lord was with me in that crash, and I know that I lived through a miracle with the Lord saving my life for something else He wants me to accomplish before I move on with Him.

Throughout this time, my soul found such peace and repose from that lovely book, and how the Lord has spoken to me through this special little book.

The simple, clear manner in which Fr. Mumford told his story and the confusion he felt in his near fatal drowning offered me profound opportunity to listen and pray more deeply. His honest experiences of healing through the laying on of hands gave me new horizons to reach out through prayer. God bless this little book...and God bless Fr. Nigel for putting into words a blessed lesson that simple people like me can understand, be thankful for, and increase our love and faith in our blessed and ever-present Holy Trinity.
