Good Lord Deliver Us! by Fr. Al Durrance

an excerpt from Chapter One: A Historical Perspective

Deliverance is much more than casting out demons. It is a complete change from the old creation which is passing away because it has been made subject to corruption. It is an introduction to the new life in God's Kingdom. We might even see it as being cast out of the old creation into the new. It is the process of being set free from all bondage to walk in the glorious liberty of the children of God...

...Fear was no longer a problem. They had no fear of death and hell. They rather had a boldness toward God as they came to the throne of Grace to meet One who was their loving Father- not a tyrant who sought to punish and destroy them. The Ruler of the Kingdom was One who loved them. As they were born again in that love, they knew Him to be their Father. The death of the flesh did not mean the end of all things. It meant rather the completion of that adoption in the redemption of the body. They would live forever with the Father in a spiritual body fit to serve God in eternity... (pp. 13 & 14)

Healing Thoughts - **Circumcision** – Kirsten Aufhammer

Joshua 5:2 At that time the LORD said to Joshua, "Make flint knives and circumcise the Israelites again." 3 So Joshua made flint knives and circumcised the Israelites at Gibeath Haaraloth.

The Israelites had just entered a new land, their promised land, where normally they could expect to be attacked by their enemies who didn't want them to come into their land. As far as the other people were concerned the Israelites were trespassing. I don't know about you, but when I come into a new situation (i.e. a health scare, a new job or a loss of a job, a change in circumstances, etc.) the last thing I want to do is have anything else asked of me. It can take a huge amount of energy trying to adjust to new surroundings or circumstances, deal with new people, and simply find my equilibrium.

I don't think I would be too happy to be told by my boss that I also needed to be circumcised at that particular moment! *Hello*, I'm in a vulnerable place physically and emotionally I don't want anybody approaching me with a sharp object! How about you?

Well, that's exactly what the Lord told Joshua to do to the Israelites. Here they were in a new land and they were about to cut off the skin in a very sensitive area of their body. Not only would there be pain involved in this procedure, but they would also need time to heal. Coming into a new land and being surrounded by enemies is not the time to be laid up in bed in pain and healing!

This called for a great deal of trust on the Israelites part. They had to trust God to protect them while they were vulnerable and while they healed. They had to have faith that He would not let anything thing happen to them or their families during this period of time. And God was faithful and did protect them. Look at what the Word tells us about the Israelites enemies.

Joshua 5:1 Now when all the Amorite kings west of the Jordan and all the Canaanite kings along the coast heard how the LORD had dried up the Jordan before the Israelites until we had crossed over, their hearts melted and they no longer had the courage to face the Israelites.

God had already gone before the Israelites and changed the hearts of the Amorites and Canaanites so that they were afraid of the Israelites. God had already set His protective plan in motion even before He told Joshua to have the Israelites circumcised. I wonder if the Israelites were aware that their enemies were afraid of them? Or were they simply obedient when they were circumcised not knowing if they were going to be attacked at any minute?

This is a good example of how we have to trust the Lord's plan for our lives regardless of how things might look from our perspective. God has a purpose for our lives and we often don't even have a clue about the awesome plans He has for us. We need to remember that He has already gone before us and smoothed our way. Our job is to be obedient to what He calls us to do. (i.e. simply wait, be a participant in our healing, change a pattern in our lives, etc.) It might not be comfortable, but it will always be for our good. God promises us that in Jeremiah 29:11-13:

11 For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. 12 Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. 13 You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart.

God's plans lead us to a hopeful future. We might not know what our future holds, but we do know Who holds our future in His Hands! Trust God and be obedient to Him. His plans for your life are so much more than you could even begin to imagine!

Prayer requests are placed in a special basket at *The Glennon House* for one month. These requests are prayed for, individually, each day by prayer volunteers.
